Data Protection Policy

The City of Canterbury Model Railway Society complies with GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR) 25 May 2018.

In order for our Club to run smoothly and efficiently, we need to hold certain personal data on paper and on computers being used by Club Officers. This information is needed for various reasons listed below.

Necessary to be able to communicate fully with Membership.

- 1) Full Name
- 2) Full Postal Address
- 3) Telephone Number (Land Line & Mobile)
- 4) Email address

Necessary to keep accurate Club records.

Historical Data, including date of joining, any Office held. Any fees paid.

Necessary to cover minor data not listed above, relevant to Club Membership. For Example - Key Holders

Any other necessary minor miscellaneous information not listed above

Under the terms of the new GDPR Act (effective from 25 May 2018) we need the consent of all parties concerned to hold the above personal data.

By signing your application form for membership you give that consent.

a) You may withdraw your consent at any time, by contacting the Hon. Secretary, explaining your reasons if possible.

b) Your personal data will be used solely for Club purposes and will not be divulged to any other third party without your prior consent.
